





1. Schritt: Nimm ein rechteckiges Blatt – am besten in rosa.







2. Schritt: Falte dein Papier einmal in der Mitte.





3. Schritt: Falte dann beide Seiten noch mal zur Mitte.











4. Schritt: Falte nun alle 4 Ecken um.



5. Schritt: Nun öffne die Ecken wieder und schiebe sie an der Faltekante nach innen, sodass 2 kleine Flügel entstehen.




6. Schritt: Mach das an allen 4 Ecken ...







7. Schritt: Falte nun dein Papier in der Mitte.







8. Schritt: Nun mach dem Schwein Beine. Falte die kleinen Flügel einmal nach Innen und dann noch mal nach Unten.





8. Schritt: Mach das an allen 4 Seiten, bis dein Schwein 4 Beine hat.





